 - Organized body paragraphs that develop your thoughts
 - A conclusion that brings your essay together
 - Essays should reflect **your own voice, ideas, and experiences**.
 - Care should be taken to ensure proper grammar, spelling, and overall clarity.

This essay is an opportunity for the selection committee to better understand who you are beyond grades and test scores. Thoughtful, well-organized responses that genuinely address the chosen question are strongly encouraged.

- *To address growing concerns about youth mental health, Florida's House Bill 3 requires children under the age of 14 to obtain parental approval before creating a social media account. Do you agree or disagree with this law, and what reasons support your position?*
- *Florida's House Bill 133 proposes lowering the minimum age to purchase a rifle from 21 to 18. Do you support or oppose this change, and what reasons shape your position?*

Scholarship Program Rules and Regulations

1. The Five-0 Foundation Scholarship, will be awarded to a qualified recipient(s) determined by the Scholarship Committee. The amount of the award is to be determined by the Executive Board of the Five-0 Foundation and is payable to the applicant.
2. The scholarship may be awarded annually up to and not exceeding a period of four (4) years upon providing proof of active enrollment in an accredited college, university or post-secondary educational institution that is recognized by the US Department of Education. A renewal application must be completed and submitted as well as a **current certified transcript**. Only those renewal applications postmarked by April 3, 2026 will be accepted. The renewal applies only to Undergraduate Degrees and will not exceed a period of four (4) years. **The recipient must be the son, daughter, grandson, granddaughter of a Fraternal Order of Police Jim Fogleman Lodge 50 current, active member who is:**
 - in good standing at the time of the application
 - active with a minimum of three years or more
3. Essays will be closely scrutinized. **Unethical uses of a generative artificial intelligence (AI) to outline, draft and write the essay in part or in its entirety will disqualify the applicant.**
4. The scholarship application must be received by April 3, 2026 **via the US Postal Service**. **The scholarship committee will not accept any applications postmarked after April 3, 2026. No other form of delivery is acceptable.** The application is to be sent to:
